"The Cocoon"

All the sanctuary lights were extinguished except for those illuminating the pulpit. As the sermon began during the midweek Lenten services, I nestled into the warm hooded coat with the satin-backed lining that my mom had made; pulling it around me so only my face was exposed. It was my own, wonderful, child-sized cocoon from which I listened to our pastor's message in the darkened church.

Lent was the only season in which I was able to cocoon. When Easter came, the evening services ended, and in a sense, I played the part of a butterfly, newly emerged from its dead-looking shroud. Mom stored the winter coat away to be handed down to my sister, and sewed for me a new Easter dress and coat.

In our Lutheran funeral liturgy for the Burial of the Dead we read verses from the sixth chapter of Romans: "We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his."

What a reason to celebrate life outside of the cocoon! Just as the butterfly symbolizes the glory of the Easter promise, breaking through the walls of its confinement, let us remember how Jesus broke the bonds of death for our salvation. The tomb could not hold him. Death will never again have the last word! The Gospel Good News that sustains us each day is that Christ is risen! Thanks be to God!

Please plan to join us in our midweek Lenten worship services each Wednesday, beginning with Ash Wednesday on March 5, 2025. The services will include the much beloved Holden Evening Prayer and a reflection to ponder during this Lenten season. Perhaps you won't be cocooned in the pews as I was as a child, but I pray you will sense the embrace of God's never-failing love holding you tightly as we, once again, intentionally make our way with Jesus to the cross and the empty tomb!

"Grounded in Hope" Lenten Season – 2025 Yellow Medicine Lutheran Church

On **Wednesday, March 5th**, we will once again enter into the liturgical season of the church year called Lent. That evening, we will gather for a **meal at 6:15 pm** and then move upstairs to the sanctuary for our **Ash Wednesday worship service at 7:00 pm with Holy Communion and the Imposition of Ashes.**

It is customary in many congregations to choose a focal point for the 40 day season of Lent as we walk together—intentionally, making our way to Holy Week and the Day of Resurrection, Easter. This year, our congregation will gather for weekly midweek services under the theme of "Grounded in Hope" — a theme that we will explore and cling to in a world in which hope sometimes seems elusive.



Please plan to join us on Wednesdays for a meal (at 6:15 pm) and worship (at 7:00 pm) that, beginning on March 12th, will include Holden Evening Prayer, much beloved by many. Throughout the Lenten season, we will focus on different facets that remind us how we are "Grounded in Hope". SAM Gwen Arneson will be leading our midweek worship services and Holden Evening Prayer. Please plan to join us!
